A medical miracle, he lived 21 years after his diagnosis during a time when such survival was unheard of. He willingly participated in research that sought to understand his remarkable longevity and also volunteered extensively at various AIDS hospices."

While he was a student at Lakewood High, Charly was in Symphonic Choir, for which he served as vice president, Concert Choir, Concert Ensemble, Symphonic Ensemble, Cinema staff, AFS Club, and the PA Announcing Staff. He was very active in Barnstormers, both on and off stage, and earned the prestigious rank of Thespian.
